The problem with tyres:

- Australians discard over 52 million EPUs* each year
- History of poor management in most states
- These tyres are illegally dumped, stockpiled, burned or exported
- Driven by a cash economy and inadequate regulation (historically)
- So why is this a problem?



^{*}Equivalent Passenger Units (EPUs), which is a standard measure for tyres

- A not-for-profit company
- Established to deliver the National Tyre Product Stewardship Scheme, which aims to:
 - Improve the sustainable management of end-of-life (waste) tyres in Australia
 - > Build a strong, profitable tyre recycling market
 - Remove poor operators from the market
- Formed by the tyre industry with endorsement of Federal Government, State and Territory Governments, ACCC
- Funded by a 25c levy on imported tyres
