
Acknowledgement of Country

CRC Grants - Round 25 - Anticipated timeline

Stage 1

- Opened 8 January 2024, closing 5 March 2024
- Outcomes announced June 2024

Stage 2

- Opening July 2024, closing August 2024
- Outcomes announced November 2024

Contract negotiation

• Up to 6 months



Start 1 July 2025

Overview of CRC Grants Eligibility


- Partners: at least one Australian industry and one Australian research organisation.
- Support medium to long term industry-led collaborations for up to 10 years.
- Grants up to 50% of eligible grant project value, with **no set funding limit**.
- CRCs must
 - aim to **solve industry identified problems** and improve the competitiveness, productivity and sustainability of Australian industries.
 - have an industry-focused education and training program (incl. a PhD program).
 - increase research and development capacity in SMEs.
 - encourage industry take up of research.

Tips for applying

What makes a successful CRC?



What makes a CRC application competitive?

- Demonstrate the need for a CRC with industry commitment and desire for change.
- Clearly outline which Government priority areas the application aligns to.
- Identify the commercial potential of the project and the commercialisation pathway.
- Appropriate partners, resources, personnel and research to address the identified industry problem.
- Strong engagement from all partners with well-defined roles.
- Contextualise responses for the CRC, avoiding generic statements or unsubstantiated claims.

How should I pick my CRC partners?

- Beyond the relevant guideline requirement there is no set limit regarding the size or composition of a CRC. However, please be aware:
 - It's not a numbers game. Effective governance and management are critical.
 - The choice of partners and their contributions need to be fit for purpose.
 - Know your partners. Be mindful of associated risks (e.g. national security and protection of IP).
 - At the application stage, Third Party contributions cannot be used for eligibility purposes to ensure matching grant funding.
 - CRCs do not have "Lead Partners". A true consortium is required for CRC success.

Are there any tips for writing an application?

- Look at the Grant Opportunity Guidelines, sample application form, sample grant agreement and any fact sheets.
- Provide sufficient detail and clarity against each of the assessment criteria. Avoid repetition.
- Use plain English and avoid using jargon and acronyms.
- Templates for Partner Declarations and Partner Contributions are provided on business.gov.au.
 Do not alter the format e.g. add conditions or unprotect spreadsheets



What should I check before submitting my application?

- Before submitting your application, check that:
 - All partner declarations are complete, signed and not amended from the required template.
 - All partners are contributing eligible cash or in-kind resources.
 - Partner contributions include sufficient detail and value justification to demonstrate Guidelines compliance
 - In-kind contributions must relate to eligible activities
 - Non-staff in-kind contributions must not relate to staff salaries (e.g. indirect costs)
 - No additional material is included in the application.
- If you are resubmitting an application, check that you have addressed all CRC Advisory Committee feedback.

How do I submit my application?

- Apply under your CRC name, not a partner's ABN.
- Applications are completed and submitted through the secure online business.gov.au customer portal.
 - The 'Apply now' section is visible on <u>business.gov.au/crc</u> when a round is open.
- No late submissions are accepted.
 - The customer portal automatically closes at 5pm on the closing date.
 - Allow enough time check your application and correct any errors before the closing time.
